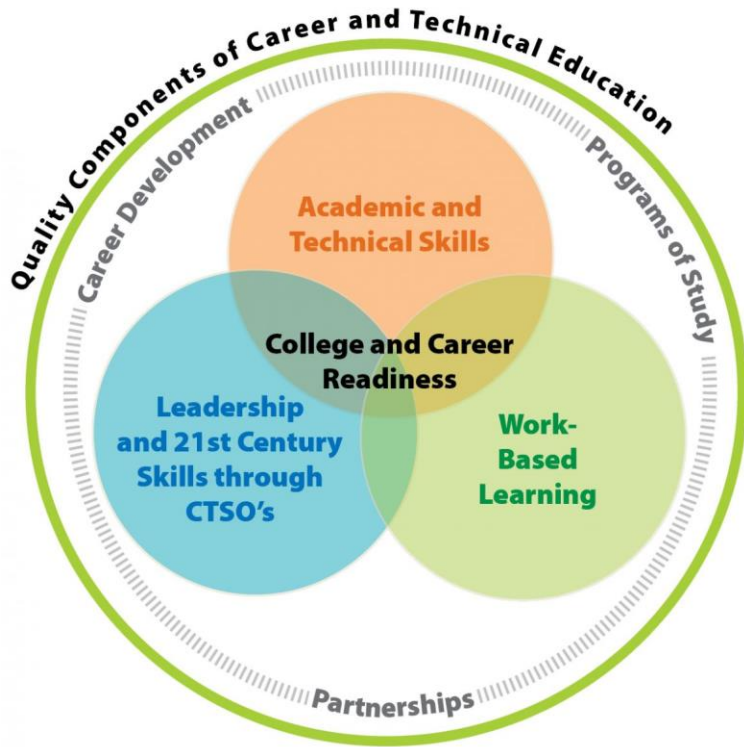

1. Develops positive relationships with others

6. Performs quality work
7. Provides quality goods or services
 - Respectful image to customers
 - Enthusiastic Attitude
8. Shows initiative and self-direction
9. Adapts to change

- *Do I have to be in work experience/work study or internship to get certified?*
- **No!**
- Example: Working as a bank teller on Saturday mornings and summers
- Example: Working as an automotive technician nights and weekends

- *Do all jobs qualify for this program?*
- **No!**

- Skilled mentors assigned to train the students
- Paid on-the-job work experience

Youth Apprenticeship Cert.

- Related classroom instruction concurrent with work-based learning
 - May include independent study courses
- Curriculum guidelines for all programs



Youth Apprenticeship Cert.

- Performance evaluation of demonstrated competencies
- State-issued skill certificate



Youth Apprenticeship Cert.

- Junior OR senior year of high school
- 2 semesters of related classroom instruction
- NOTE: Summer hours before the school year *and* beyond the school year count!
